Dear Valued Customer,

Campbell Soup Company is voluntarily recalling 14.2 oz cans of SpaghettiOs Original with a date of February 22, 2017, and UPC Code of 51000 22432.

This is due to a potential choking hazard posed by pieces of red plastic found in a small number of cans. This plastic material is from parts of the can lining which may peel off.

The affected product is as shown:



The issue was identified after the company received consumer complaints. This recall affects 355,000 cans and is limited to the United States.

People who have bought this product should not eat it. We are asking consumers to return affected cans to the store where they were purchased for an exchange or full refund. 
We are asking that you remove these products from shelves immediately and destroy them. We will provide full reimbursement upon receipt of the Affidavit of Destruction (see attached form).
